The International Trombone Festival wishes to appoint up to twenty (20) students to assist in the running of ITF2006 to be held July 20-23, 2006 at Birmingham Conservatoire, Birmingham, England.

As a student worker, you will gain invaluable experience and knowledge of the workings of a major international music festival, develop lasting relationships with ITF artists and performers, and enjoy all aspects of the ITF performances first-hand.

Students will receive free tuition to the festival, dorm room accommodation, free car park pass, and two ITF staff t-shirts. You will be expected to work on a rotating shift pattern totalling about 8 hours each day. There is no remuneration for this post. Limited bursaries for travel are available on request. Depending on budget costs a per diem food allowance may also become available. Students must be aged 18 or above.

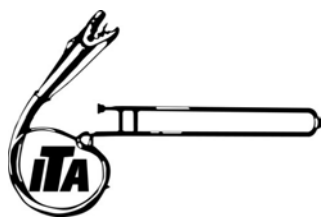
